She went on to win 2 National Championships with the Lady Techsters in 1981 and 1982. Debbie later put on the stripes and served on officiating staffs for several different conferences, and would eventually take on the role as NCAA National Coordinator of Women's Officials in 2011. Prior to that, she served as Secretary Rules Editor for the NCAA, and also served on the board for the National Association of Sport Officials (NASO). Today, Debbie currently serves as the Supervisor of Women's Officials for the following conferences: ACC, American Athletic, Atlantic 10, Big East, Big South, Colonial, Ivy League, MAAC and Southern Conference.

Joe Vaszily

Joe is entering his 21st season as an NCAA D-I Women's Basketball Official. Vaszily has been a full-time referee in women's college basketball for seven years now. Before that he worked in finance in New York, earning an MBA and becoming a certified public accountant along the way. At Goldman Sachs, he became vice president in the fixed income division. Still, it was his side job refereeing games that became his driving passion. He has worked 5 ACC Championship games, 17 NCAA Tournaments, and has 8 Final Four appearances.
